## Benefits of Membership

NLASLPA is committed to providing continuing education opportunities for its members. It is our mission to support the professional needs of our members.

We provide professional development opportunities through our annual conference, sponsorship of various educational events, corporate discounts, and distribution of information for education opportunities provincially and nationally.

- NLASLPA hosts an annual two day conference featuring a full-day keynote speaker for each of the two professions, and opportunities for networking and socialization. NLASLPA members pay a reduced fee to attend the conference.
- NLASLPA offers yearly education funding draws. Each year members can submit an application for individual education sponsorship, which can be found in the membership section of our website.
